FAQS:

- Tigers (6 yrs old or 1st grade) **MUST** have an Adult Partner (18+) with them at all times to attend camp.
- Scout age (6-10yrs/1st-5th grade) siblings/family/friends are welcome at Camp!!! Just be sure to complete a Registration/Medical Form for every child (Registration cost is \$125 for unregistered youth, which will register them with central GA council through Dec 2018)
- A "Tot Lot" will be available for Leader's children under 6 yrs. Please Indicate/Register younger siblings on the Leader Registration Form.
- Every Pack attending **MUST** send Parent Volunteers. A Pack with 1-5 Campers must send ONE Volunteer, 5+ Campers require TWO Volunteers, 10+ requires THREE, etc. Remember, this is a volunteer run program, and we couldn't do it without YOU!!! ** Also, this doesn't have to be the same people all week. We completely understand that not everyone can be here for 5 days, and we appreciate any time you put into making this program a success!***
- We need YOUTH VOLUNTEERS!!! Brothers, Sisters, Cousins, ages 11-18 are welcome and encouraged to come Volunteer and be Counselors In Training (CITs). We will give credit for Service Hours Earned. Just complete the leader registration form.
- **Parent Orientation is the evening before Camp begins. You must Attend to pick up your T-Shirts and Pick-up Card. This is a "Drop-In" Orientation and you should be in and out in 20 minutes.**
- "Campfire" and Awards Program will be on Friday June 8. Parents are asked to come on Campus at Lunch to picnic and tour the program stations. We will gather for a "Campfire" style program where the Campers receive awards and show off everything they have been working on during the week.
- Everyone will receive an "Accomplishments Report" on Friday, showing what requirements were met for each Cub Scout rank during the week at camp.
- We will be getting WET!! Send a change of clothes and/or towel.
